It is always recommended that you secure your tent properly with safety straps and augers when you put up the structure.


We recommend you to insure the tent, or check if it is covered by home contents insurance, in case of unplanned events, accidents or bad weather.

Tents are meant as temporary shelter and must be evacuated under extreme weather conditions.

This structure is not tested for specific snow and wind loads. That's why we always recommend to remove snow from the top.







Step 1: Lay out and connect the basic shape as shown above.Step 2: Fasten the connections as shown in I.




Step 3: Build up the roof structure as shown above,Step 4: Put no. 01 through No. 10 and top of with No. 12



Step 5: Put the roofcover on the frame.


Step 6: Assemble the legs as shown in III

Step 7: Raise the structure one side at a time using the legs, the fasten the legs to the roof as shown in IV.




Step 8: fasten the structure to the ground using Stake pegs (No. 14).


Step 9: Apply the hook from roofcover to Legs as shown in V. **Step 10:** Fasten roofcover with bungeeballs (No. 17) as shown in VI.



Step 11: Tighten the Roofcover using No. 02 as shown above.



Step 11: Use the plastic rings (No. 16) to place the sidewalls (No. 19).



Step 11: Use the plastic rings (No. 16) to fasten the curtains (No. 20) at the corners.

Step 12: Fasten structure to ground using guy lines (No. 15) and stake pegs (No 14)

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
